Greystone Manor Therapeutic Riding Center is getting ready to begin our 29th year. Our mission is to provide a safe therapeutic horseback riding program to our riders. We can only achieve our mission with the help of many dedicated volunteers who give their time and support throughout the year. We are so very grateful for our volunteers and we look forward to working with returning volunteers as well as welcoming new volunteers to the program. People who wish to volunteer with the program must be at least 14 years of age. Volunteers will have opportunities to work with our riders, horses, and staff through **6-week sessions, clinics, horse show, ride-a-thon, group lessons and horsemanship youth camp**. New volunteers are welcome to join us at any time during the year.

We are excited to begin our sessions this year on March 1 at Greystone Manor Therapeutic Riding Center, located at 1063 Hartman Station Road, Lancaster. The enclosed calendar lists all the important dates for the 2010 season. Please keep it handy for easy reference.
